COURSE

The world's flattest 5-mile distance run course....very fast. Race will begin and end at Williams Wharf Landing (end of Route 614, Williams Wharf Road). The course is out-and-back on rural roads with little traffic. Most of the course is on paved roads.....a short section is on well-packed sand and gravel roads.

PARTICIPANTS

The 5-Mile race is open to ALL ages.

Age groups for boys and girls, men and women are:

9 and under, 10-13, 14-17, 18-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, and 60 and over.

COURSE

The course for the one-mile pet walk will be four circuits around the grounds of beautiful and scenic Williams Wharf Landing, a Mathews Land Conservancy property. This historic old steamboat landing is the home of numerous rowing regattas. The Landing is open to the public for non-motorized small craft launching from the large, modern floating dock. Fishing is permitted in designated areas.
